

# HOW TO LESS HOUSE, MORE HOME

## CLUB COUTURE™ PROJECT

### Supplies Needed

**Club Couture™ Transfer:** Less House, More Home

**Chalkology™ Paste Singles:** Tide, Cadet, Regal

**Tools:** Small Squeegee, Mini Squeegee, Transfer Trimmers, Fuzzing Cloth, Self-Healing Work Mat

**Surface:** Box Frame (9" x 12")

### Color and Placement for Club Couture™: Less House, More Home

1. Less House, More Home words: Regal (or Cadet as desired)
2. House with heart: Tide

### Follow these instructions to complete the Club Couture™ project:

1. Prepare your Chalk Transfer™ design by removing it from the packaging.
2. When you remove the backer from the Transfer screen, be sure to “fuzz” each element to gentle the adhesive by sticking the adhesive screen to a Fuzzing Cloth or terry cloth towel to pick up a bit of lint before applying it to your board.
3. Position your first Transfer element and smooth to adhere to your surface, ensuring there are no bubbles.
4. Prepare your Paste Singles by kneading the packets, cutting the corners, and squeezing desired amounts onto dishes or other palette surfaces. Stir paste if using 3 US fl. oz. jars.
5. Smooth the Regal (or Cadet, as desired) paste across the words, “Less House, More Home” and squeegee off any excess.
6. Next, use your Mini Squeegee to spread Tide paste across the small house in the center.
7. Squeegee the excess paste off as evenly as possible and carefully peel back the Transfer before the paste dries.
8. Place the Transfer in water for cleaning.
9. Once the Transfer element is clean and dry, reapply the backer and store flat.
